The Admission Process

Our Admissions Department is staffed 24/7. To expedite the process and admission decision, please have the following information available:

- Reason for referral
- Identifying information for child (Name, DOB, Social Security number, address and home phone number, address of guardian if different from child)
- · Custody arrangements and how this was verified
- Legal Status (201, 302, 303)
- Current medications with dosages, frequencies and last dose given
- · Descriptions of any medical issues
- Funding sources and precertification information
- Recent lab test results.
- Co-occurring medical conditions to be reviewed by the pediatrician and a psychiatrist
- If the child has dropped out of school and/or is emancipated.

Youth who meet the following conditions need to be reviewed on a case-by-case basis:

- IQ scores less than 70
- Pregnancy- to be reviewed by a physician
